This event will be held from **25 to 27 September 2021** in Ternate, Indonesia. We look forward to meeting you and value your contribution to the ongoing success of this annual conference.

The conference theme is **Role of Victimology in Protecting Cultural Heritage, Indigenous People and Diversity**. Under the conference theme, we will, as far as possible, group papers within broad subject areas, and will form panels on this basis. The broad subject areas as sub-theme will include:

1. Protecting Cultural Heritage and Indigenous People;
2. Restorative Justice;
3. Victim on Criminal Justice System;
4. Cyber Victimology;
5. Green Victimology;
6. Corruption in Victimology Perspective;
7. Penology in Victimology Perspective;
8. Victim in Abuse of Power;
9. Victim of Natural Disaster;
10. Victim of Accident & Technological Failure;
11. General Topic on Victimology.

The papers will be selected on a competitive basis. Presentation in conference only applicable to presenters whose abstracts have been accepted for the parallel session. All presenters are required to submit full paper and the selection will be done jointly by the committee.

Participants should indicate the title of their paper and the proposed panel category (based on the list provided), to assist in the category process. Please read the following instructions carefully before submitting abstract and full paper.

### General guidelines for abstract submission

1. Title of paper, are written with Times New Roman Bold (14pt) and preferably not more than 14 words.
2. Author(s) name, affiliations, e-mail, contact person.
3. Category Sub-Theme
4. Abstract should be clear no more than 250 words. This abstract should provide a brief introduction to the problem, objective of paper, followed by a statement regarding the method and a brief summary of results. Font with Times New Roman (12pt), single spacing.
5. Keywords arranged by alphabetically and should have at least two keywords and maximum five keywords separated by a semicolon (;)

### General guidelines for full paper

1. The word limit for the submission is 5000-6000 words (including of footnotes, abstract and references), font with Times New Roman (12pt), 1.5spacing, around 15 pages.
2. The sequence of full paper following: Title; Abstract; Keywords; Introduction; Method (optional only for original research articles); Analysis and Discussion; Conclusion; and References.
3. Citation in Footnotes should be written in *Turabian Style* 9<sup>th</sup> edition.
4. References at the end of paper, should be written in *Turabian Style* 9<sup>th</sup> edition. With category Books, Journal articles: Regulation, World Wide Web, etc.
5. Speaker's Bio: Brief description of professional status, education background and experience in no more than 250 words. Please do not submit your CVs.

### Plagiarism and Review Policy

Plagiarism and self-plagiarism are not allowed. The authors should ensure that they have written entirely original works, and never submit into other conference or publication. If the authors have used the work and/or words of others that this has been appropriately cited or quoted. Editorial team will checking by using Turnitin (no more than 25%).
